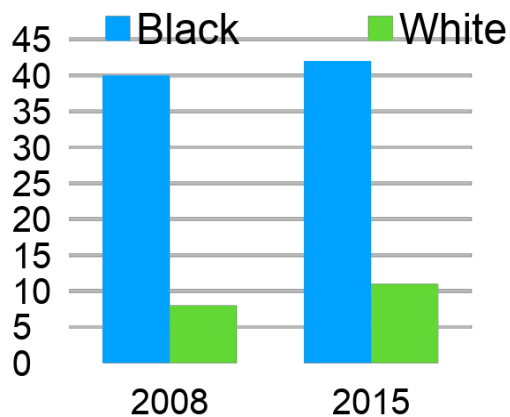

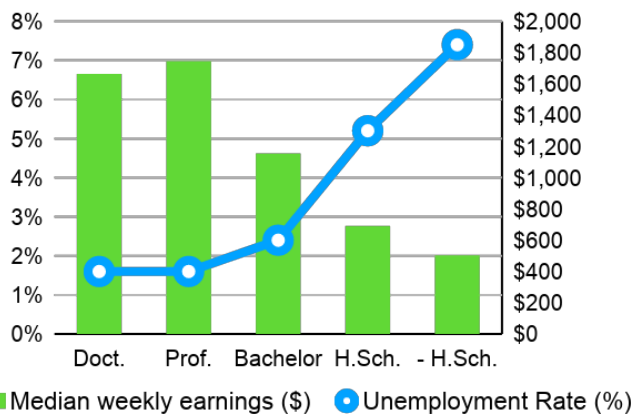

APPRENTICESHIP

The 2018 **BELONGING & BECOMING Apprenticeship** will highlight Tiny Business & Entrepreneurship. It is starting with a Mentorship Program following our three goals.

We are looking for self-motivated apprentices for the program, which will take place at different sites. To be eligible you must be between 16 and 24 years old and available for 4 to 10 hours a week. A specific schedule will be made with your mentor.

With an inter-generational and inter-racial team, the apprentice/intern will be expected to assist and share knowledge, ideas and skills in some of the following areas:

- Researching and conducting Interviews
- Researching History of Tiny Businesses as well as their presence and impact today
- Studio work using multi-media techniques
- Documentation work: data filing, recording...
 - Administrative work and planning
 - Performances and conducting Tours.

The Apprenticeship pays a stipend depending on age and number of hours.

Youths under 18 need parental consent.

You will be notified no later than May 10th.

There will be a mandatory introduction meeting for all selected apprentices

Conversations will be about conNECKtedTOO and your goals, skills and expectations.
